**Road Closures**

- Brock Road (Regional Road 1) from north of Ninth Concession Road (Regional Road 5) to 200 metres north of Uxbridge Pickering Townline Road, in the City of Pickering and Township of Uxbridge, July 17 to October 23, 2024- Daily Lane restrictions will be required for the duration of the project to facilitate road rehabilitation on Brock Road. Culvert replacements, ditching, pulverizing of existing asphalt and granular base, placement of asphalt.
- Concession Road 7 (Regional Road 1) from 200 metres south of Sandford Road (Regional Road 11) to 400 metres north of Ashworth Road, and from 100 metres south of Foster Drive to Harrison Drive, July 16 to December 2024 – Closed for Pavement reconstruction, including shoulder, replacement of culverts and installation of guide rail.
